## **POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

**Masks:** Carol Torok Volleyball Camps staff will wear masks at all times. Depending on the state or local orders in place, camp participants may choose to wear masks during athletic participation. Masks will be required at Check-In and as participants enter and exit the facility.

**Water Breaks:** Campers will be asked to bring their own water bottles and no community water fountains will be available. They will be released for breaks at different times to prevent crowding. Campers will be asked to use hand sanitizer/wash their hands during each water break before they are allowed to return to their court.

**Social Distancing:** Campers are encouraged to place their equipment (water bottles, bags, etc.) away from others. Only campers and coaches are allowed onto the courts. Parents are encouraged to watch from the facility's viewing area or the surrounding track.

**Cleanliness:** Post camp session, we will have a cleaning station where staff will wipe down all equipment (balls, carts, props, etc) before they are placed into storage.
